Motion by Hills, second by Hilgerson to approve a liquor license for Valley Fresh Market. Carried 4-0.

Council had the second reading of Ordinance 320. This ordinance approves the Code book updates. With no public input, a motion by Knobloch and a second by Popenhagen to approve this ordinance was carried 3-1 with a nay vote from Hills and the same reason as last vote – he doesn't feel enough time was put in reviewing the changes.
